Babies (0-1 year)

These foundational classes for the littlest learners are the perfect fit to support baby's development and sheer delight! The connections with other moms and your educator's expert knowledge on child and brain development make these classes the best foundation for parents too. In this sensory rich environment that combines listening, vocal play, object exploration, bonding, dancing and movement, you and your baby are destined to thrive, building a strong foundation for your baby's learning and life skills.



Young Toddlers (1-2 years)

Young toddlers are all about exploring and reacting to new sounds, objects and movements. During this crucial phase of development, they are in need of a safe environment with the right support to help them gain confidence, move, groove and speak! Our expert educators intertwine parenting tips and child development knowledge effortlessly during each weekly class, providing you with the tools you need to be your child's very best (and most important) teacher! You can expect singing, group dances, instrument play, new friends, connection and lots of encouragement in our Level 1 classes.



Older Toddlers (2-3 years)

Let the energy and curiosity unite! Level 2 classes are all about exploring creativity and enhancing cognitive development through singing, dancing, and instrument play, while grownups learn how to help unpack big emotions with music. You can expect vocal play and sound identification, exploration of language patterns, discovery of instruments and musical concepts and plenty of movement and socialization! In addition to cognitive development, your toddler will strengthen the fine motor skills needed to write and whole body skills such as balance, self-control and the ability to regulate movement.



Preschoolers (3-4 years)

It's time to tap into the preschooler's natural love of music! Level 3 classes use music to boost language skills, confidence, social-emotional skills, self-control, and more. In this drop-off class, parents and caregivers join near the end of class to participate in the music-making. At this level, we begin to explore ensemble development, pre-reading music, creative expression and instrument play all leading the way to the next step in your child's unfolding musical journey, Explorers Preparatory, the first phase of our Performing Artist Program. Your child will gain cognitive and listening skills, language understanding and socialization that provides the readiness they require for the group classes and one-on-one lessons to come in the Performing Artist Program student journey.

In-Class Support

Whether it's you (the parent/guardian), a grandparent, a nanny, aunt, uncle or family friend, your child will thrive with an engaged caregiver by their side. Leaving distractions (including cell phones) outside the classroom and joining us with the mindfulness of being present, actively participating and modelling great listening skills are the keys to unlocking all the magic that Kindermusik has in store.

- Holiday Performance Week: Professional video recording experience in-studio during one week in December culminating in a full length Holiday Video Recital showcasing all performers.
 Performances by all students attending lessons and Performing Artist Program ensembles in place of lessons and classes.
- Ignite the Spark Showcase: peer-only attended small group showcases during the last week of February. Performances by all students attending lessons and Performing Artist Program ensembles in place of lessons and classes.
- Amazing Fun Park Stage: Performance stage in Mississauga for all students and Performing Artist Program ensembles.
- Clarkson Village Live: A community event held in Clarkson village on a Saturday in June.
- Spring Recitals: Live professional recital experience held in a local performance venue during one week in June. Performances by all students attending lessons, Kindermusik and Performing Artist Program ensembles in place of lessons and classes.

We do offer make-up classes for families enrolled in our school year Kindermusik program only. Make-ups are available provided you remain enrolled in the program and to not carry forward after withdrawal or if the program ends at any time. You can book your make-up online via the parent portal in any age appropriate class with spaces available. Keep in mind that if our programs are full, make-ups will not be available.

On the even rarer occasion of your instructor being absent, a substitute instructor, virtual or make-up class option will be provided based on the circumstances.
